Late H.B. Lakhtakia Memorial (Former President Allahabad District Table Tennis Association) The 34th Junior U.P. State Championships 'U.P.CUP' Powered by 'STAG' will be held at MAJOR RANJEET SINGH INDOOR STADIUM, ALLAHABAD from 7 – 9 June, 2019 conducted by the Allahabad District Table Tennis Association. UP CUP: - (Junior, Sub-Jr. and Cadet)

- 1. First 2 players will be treated as Team Members in UP CUP (Junior State). Additional entries in Junior State (UP Cup) will be restricted to 6 only instead of 4 (viz. 2 team member and 6 additional = 8 max. in each category.) Presently, in the Junior State Table Tennis Championships (UP CUP), players representing District Teams are entitled for free boarding and lodging along with entry fee of Rs. 3000/- per district. However, it is has been decided that additional players participating in each event in the championships (UP CUP) will also be provided with complete Boarding and Lodging. Entry fee will be Rs.1500/- per event. Entry fee Rs. 1000/- will be charged per additional event.
- 2. Team members are allowed to play one event of higher category in UP CUP and ranked players are allowed to play in two events of higher category, but the **District Association has to give the names, event-wise.**
- 3. It is often seen that some districts are not sending their team in the UP Cup. It has been decided that it should be made mandatory for all the districts to send their team in the UP cup. If they fail to send their team in UP Cup, UPTTA should impose a fine of Rs.3000/- to the concerned district.
- 4. The players from such district, where no district Association exists or have failed to enter his team, will also be eligible to participate in the tournament as additional entry.
- 5. Registration Fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only) per annum per player would be compulsory with immediate effect.

Submission of required age documents, TTFI reserves the rights to independently investigate in visual the authenticity of the Age Certificate. Over age players will be liable for disciplinary action in case their certificates are found to be not genuine. It shall be the responsibility of District Association Secretaries that the above guidelines are strictly complied with and also to check the authenticity of Birth Certificate at the time of submission by a player. Without submission of above age documents no players will be allowed to participate in the tournament.

All the secretaries are requested to submit proof of age of their players immediately. Previously it was seen some districts did not send certificates despite repeated reminders. Last minutes submission will not be accepted this year.

All the ranked players in all categories (1 to 8) must confirm their entry in writing through their concerned districts in all the tournaments and send its copy to the UPTTA as per mandatory rules. However players can withdraw their names at least 5 days before the tournament, otherwise 60 points would be deducted from their accrued points.

As per practice, the District Association sends entry in the tournaments, but unfortunately, most of the time some players do not turn up for the tournament. As a result the Host Association faces financial loss for booking Hotels and their other arrangements also go in vain. Thus, it has been decided that the unranked players who do not turn up should be barred for the next tournament and District Association will have to bear the entry fee on their part.

It has been noticed that the units do not send their entries on time and are late in arriving at the venue of the tournament which results in delay of the matches and re-draw of the fixtures etc. This practice is being repeated more often in every tournament. It is therefore advised to all the units/players to submit their entries positively before the last date of the entries and a copy of which to be sent to the undersigned. The host/chief referee will entertain no last minute entry. The matches will commence from 11.00 A.M. Players from every district can participate only in two events.

Ranking and U.P. State Championships:

- 6. That in all U.P. State Ranking Table Tennis Tournaments, **5 additional players will** be allowed in each category instead of 3 with an entry fee of Rs. 1000/-. Maximum 10 players can participate (5 + 5 additional). In youth, maximum 8 players can participate (3 + 5 additional). Players from every district can participate only in two events. One being his/her main event and the second event will be one category higher (restriction of entries will be applicable).
- 7. State current Ranked or Classified (as per the latest Ranked/Classification list) top four players can participate in two higher events.
- 8. That an Entry Fee of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) should be imposed **per player per event** for Team members only, including all ranked players in all categories (viz. Senior, Youth, Junior, SubJunior and Cadet) for participating in **all the U.P. State Ranking Tournaments and State Championships** with immediate effect.
- 9. That the Same conditions will be applied in 5 Zones teams for additional players for the **State Championships** as proposed in Item No. 6 but with an entry fee of **Rs. 3000/-.**
- 10. No players will be allowed to play in a higher event <u>automatically</u> in any tournament / championships in the State. District Association has to give the names event-wise. First 5 players will be treated as team members in each event except youth and 6th onwards will be treated as additional entry. In youth, the first 3 players will be treated as team member and 4th onwards will be treated as additional entry.

- 11. The host district can enter a maximum of **14 entries** (including additional entries) in each event. **However, UPTTA** has the discretion to increase the maximum entries in case necessary.
- 12. The entry fee collected during the UP Cup, all the Rankings and State Table Tennis Championships will be divided in the ratio 60:40 for host association and UPTTA. TA/DA of the technical officials will be borne by the U.P. Table Tennis Association. Decent hospitality and transportation to technical officials will be provided by the Host Association.
- 13. District Association should send their entries serial wise and according to their district ranking.
- 14. Sub Junior Boys/Girls and Cadet Boys/Girls events will be best-of-five games throughout. Women, Youth Girls and Junior Girls events will be best-of-five games throughout, except the **semifinals and finals.** Junior Boys and Youth Boys will be of best-of five games up to the quarter final stages and thereafter in the best-of-seven games format from the **quarterfinals onwards**. **Men's** events will be of best-of-five game up to the pre-quarterfinals stages and thereafter best-of-seven games from Pre-Quarterfinals onwards.
- 15. Age certificate must be sent with players participating in youth, junior, sub junior and cadet event.
- 16. The Hall should be big enough to accommodate minimum of 6 tables.
- 17. We will accept entries only on prescribed entry form (Approved in UPTTA AGM). No entries will be accepted after the deadline. Further you are advised not to send the entries on Phone/Plane paper/SMS.
